THEME

Nematodes as an animal group have remained very obscure for a long time except of course for some species that were known since antiquity as parasites of man himself. The reasons for this lack of interest could be many but the fact that nematodes remain by and large are hidden organisms. Nematodes have their own economic values not only because of harmful to plants and animals but beneficial too to control the insect pests. Progress in the field of identification is still continuing and new species are being added time to time but it needs tremendous research effort to know the "monopolized kingdom of nematode" very well. It has been estimated that there may be over one million species of nematodes. However, roughly above 30,000 species have been described so far.

The present scenario shows that, Nematode Taxonomy is highly emphasizing on molecular aspects followed by biochemical identification but still, classical taxonomy, based on morphological characters is extremely important for identification of the species as morphology of an organism to a great extent, is a clear manifestation of its genetic makeup or constitution. Therefore, it has ever remained a key component and back for taxonomic research. The important contribution by various workers in the field of Nematology seems to be low because of the Phylum Nematoda is taxonomically, ecologically, and geographically diverse group. Lack of adequate taxonomic expertise has been major constraints to identify the species of nematodes. Workshop shall be focussed on to expose the young budding scientists for the identification of nematodes by using modern tools and techniques.

About Host Institute

Chaudhary Charan Singh University (formerly, Meerut University) was established in 1965, to cater to the needs of higher education in western Uttar Pradesh. Posters: The size of the poster shall be 75cm x 100cm with briefly showing Title, Methodology, important Results (along with not more three tables/figures/photographs) and bulleted Summary. The poster shall be made attractive preferably on a single sheet with appropriate colour scheme so that the content is readable from a distance of at least one meter.

Two Trainees, below the age of 35 years shall be selected for the Best Trainee Awards and will be honoured with Medal and Certificate. To encourage and develop the scientific temper amongst the participants of the symposium, Best Oral and Poster Presentation Awards (02 in each group) shall be selected and will be honoured with Medal and Certificate.


